STEPHEN FUND PROVIDES

PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES to disadvantaged children, their parents and any others who cannot pay the full fee for services. Clients range in age from preschoolers to the elderly and represent all races and ethnic groups. We offer hope and help in lives that may seem hopeless and joyless.

The most common presenting problems:

- Child physical and/or sexual abuse victims
- Domestic violence victims
- Substance Abuse (drugs, alcohol)
- Depression, anxiety disorders
- Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- Problems related to poverty
- Marital and/or Family problems

Our goal is that family members will learn new coping skills, become more self-sufficient and improve family relationships.

As they realize that change is happening, they develop increasing hope and realize they too can dream and grow.



GOALS

- Provide professional services in a manner consistent with our Christian faith
- Increase individual and family functioning
- Improve family relationships
- Increase dependability at work through lower absenteeism
- Increase awareness of the effects of violence on women and children and empower women to provide safety for themselves and their families
- Wherever possible, connect people with a healing community in the Christian church
- Support single parents in their efforts to be godly parents
